All required forms and addenda receipt must accompany proposal submittal to the RFP. Failure to include any required forms and/or addenda receipt may result in rejection of proposals.

The Commissioner of Public Works, and Milwaukee Water Works reserves the right to reject any and all proposals and accept only such proposals as is in the best interest of the City of Milwaukee, Milwaukee Water Works.

There is a goal 10% Residence Preference Program (RPP) for the “repair” portion of this contract, and will be considered in the overall Proposal Evaluation Criteria.
